1942



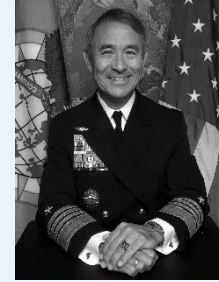
In 1942, Susan Anh Cuddy became the first Asian American woman to enlist in the U.S. Navy. She served as a member of Women Accepted for Volunteer Emergency Service, or WAVES. Later, she became the Navy's first female gunnery officer.

1984



Major General John Liu Fugh became the first Chinese American general officer in the U.S. Army and served for 32 years as a military lawyer. He created the Army's first environmental law division and the procurement fraud division. He retired as The Judge Advocate General, the top lawyer for the Army.

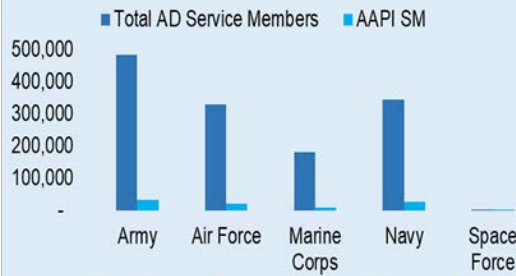
2013



Admiral Harry B. Harris Jr. is the first Asian American to achieve 4-star rank in the U.S. Navy. After retiring from the Navy, Harris served as U.S. Ambassador to South Korea.

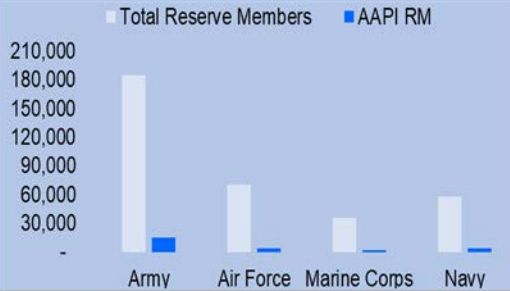

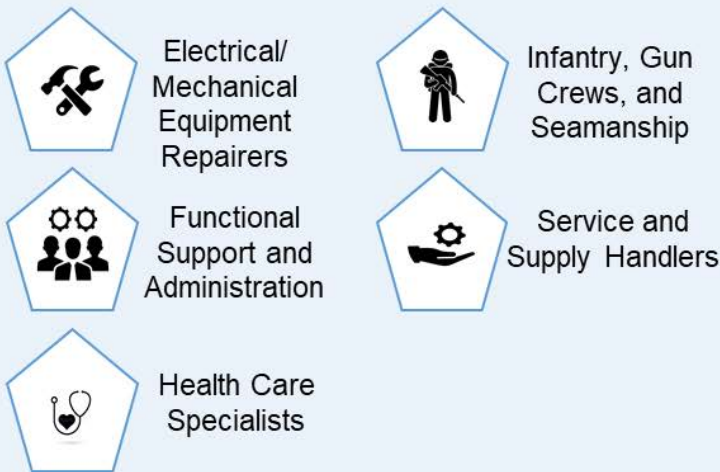

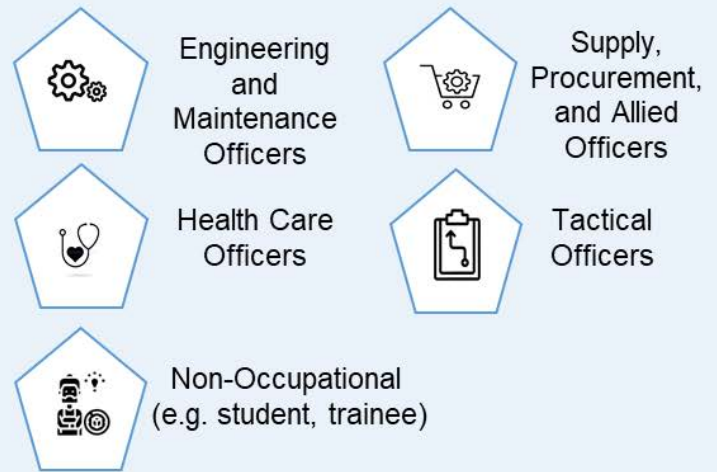

Top Five Career Fields of AAPI in the Services

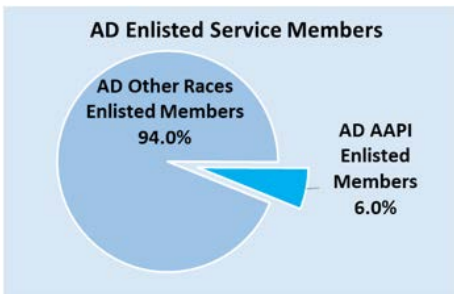

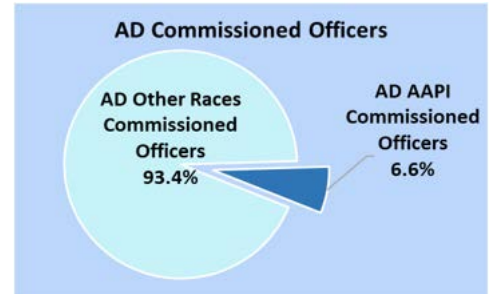

1973



Antonio Borja Won Pat, the son of an immigrant from Hong Kong, became the first Territorial Delegate from Guam. He played an essential role in the passage of the Organic Act of Guam, which granted the people of Guam U.S. citizenship.

2012



In 2012, Mazie K. Hirono became the first Asian American woman elected to the U.S. Senate and the first woman to represent the state of Hawaii. Hirono is also the first Japanese-born U.S. Senator and continues to serve today.

2021



On April 27, 2021, Heidi Shyu was nominated by President Biden to serve as the Under Secretary of Defense for Research and Engineering. She is the highest ranking Asian American civilian at the Pentagon.

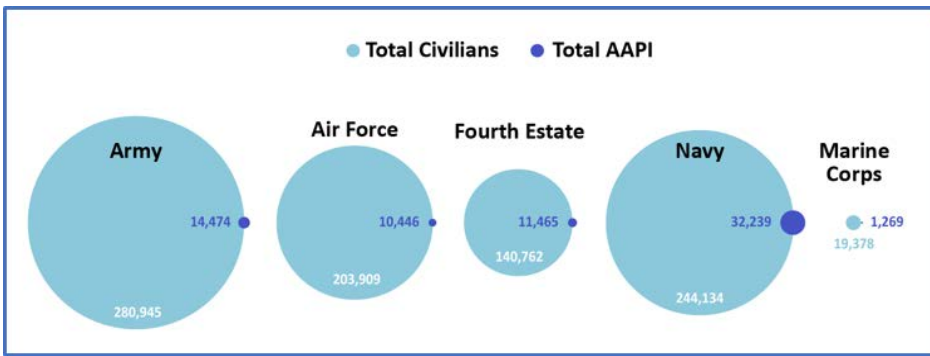

GS-1 – GS-15 Civilians

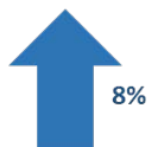
